


### APSDA Y2022 1st Board Meeting

#### 13 Jan 2022 Online

During the meeting, APSDA introduced TAC Management Sdn Bhd as the new secretary group to oversee administrative matters. On the agenda was the forming of the APSDA Professional Practice Committee to work on white paper competency, as well as the forming of the APSDA Education Policy Committee to identify recognised institutes of higher learning (IHLs) offering interior design degree programmes in the Asia-Pacific.





### APSDA Y2022 2nd Board Meeting

#### 17 February 2022 Online

At this board meeting, the Korean Society of Interior Architects and Designers (KOSID) officially became a full member of the APSDA, aligned with the APSDA's role as a coalition of national design associations from the Asia and Oceania region.

KOSID is a non-profit organisation under the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure Transport, and aimed to enhance both the quality of the human environment and the culture. The development of society ensures that interior designers' rights and interests are protected, friendships among

members are fostered, and knowledge, information and experience about interior architectural design are shared to benefit the public interest of the region and society.


The APSDA also formally announced that Asia Designers Directory (ADD), an online platform and directory of interior designers, has become its official media partner. This strategic partnership allows APSDA to reach out to a wider audience in the region, in line with ADD's vision to support meaningful touchpoints for those in search of a designer for their next space, and connectivity among creatives looking to establish synergistic collaborations and growth in the design industry.






Putting Health at the Core (of the New Normal) – Design for Health & Well-Being

#### 18 August 2022 Online

One of the key agendas of the board meeting was proposing the event budget and pipeline for 2023. In line with ASPDA's long-term objectives, suggestions for the event budget and pipeline were made as a new calendar year beckoned. APSDA also shared that it is a supporting organisation of the ADF Design Award 2023. ADF (NPO Aoyama Design Forum) is a non-profit organisation established in Japan in 2009. ADF aims to train and improve the status of designers worldwide. The theme of this year's international design award is "Design for Architecture" as the organiser explores architectural creations that are not only beautiful on the outside, but also have unique and cutting-edge design processes.

Lastly, board members were briefed about APSDA's first webinar, titled "Putting Health at the Core". The webinar delved into the future of health, well-being, and the new normal at workplaces. Aimed to encourage awareness of mental health across all industries and professions, the webinar gathered 273 signups. During the discussion, board members put forth thoughts and strategies to yield increased engagement for future webinars.



### The Way We Work: Post-Pandemic Era

8 December 2022 Online



Entitled "The Way We Work 5.0: Interior Design Update", this webinar was presented by Bingah Suseno, the project director of CDA International, Jakart. The webinar provided participants with insight on the key elements of clients in the post-pandemic era and discussed how to design a physical and online environment creatively to promote wellness and well-being.

Moderated by IDr. Joy Ejercito, the webinar offered understanding on the impacts of the pandemic, reasons why we go back to work, what attracts employees to go back to work, and how to accommodate them. Having worked in the industry for more than 20 years, Bingah Suseno discussed current trends and how interior designers work in the post-pandemic age. Workplace wellness, which entails biophilic design, ergonomics, acoustics, amenities, and artwork, was highlighted as a way to create a high-productivity environment. Sustainability in interior design was also discussed as one of the keys to long-lasting designs. Along with receiving advice on how to adjust to this "new normal", attendees from Indonesia, Malaysia, and Singapore were also given CPD credits. The session concluded with a Q&A session.


